A level results have improved with the number of pupils with 3 AAB grades in facilitating subjects being nearly double the target

Number of students getting into university has risen to 90% (62/69 students have successfully secured a university place) with 18% going to study at Russell Group Universities as well as academic courses with good career prospects demonstrating GBA's ability to offer and support a wide range of subjects leading to a variety of degrees.
