

Dear Parent/Carer

I hope you and your family are doing well.

This letter is a brief reminder of the arrangements from Monday 29<sup>th</sup> June onwards for pupils in year 10.

In summary the next three weeks will operate as follows. Your child will have been given a start and finish time depending on their form group. The earliest start time is 8.30am and the latest finish time is 1.50pm. If your child is not clear on their start time they should attend school at 9.00am.

### **Monday 29<sup>th</sup> June – Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July**

Pupils will be invited into school, again in form groups on the following dates.

- Monday 29<sup>th</sup> June/Monday 6<sup>th</sup> July/Monday 13<sup>th</sup> July - 10B1, 10B2, 10B3
- Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> June/Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> July/Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> July - 10D1, 10D2, 10D3, 10ACE
- Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> July, Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> July, Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> July - 10F1, 10F2, 10F3
- Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> July, Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> July, Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> July - 10J1, 10J2, 10J3, 10ISU

When pupils are on site they will be grouped into teaching bubbles of a maximum of 10 students allowing for sufficient social distancing between students in classrooms. Students will arrive at different times on a rolling timetable. It is important that they attend at the time allocated to them. These times will have been agreed with your child during the academic review meeting.

### **Uniform**

Pupils should be in normal school uniform. However, there is no need to wear or bring a blazer.

### **Equipment and Food**

Pupils should bring their own equipment to school, pen, pencil, ruler.

Pupils should also bring their own food and drink to consume during break time. A sandwich and drink will be available for pupils who are in receipt of a free school meal.

Thank you for supporting school staff who have been in touch with your child over the last two weeks. We encourage pupils to come to school on their allocated days. This is the best way to support the learning of your child in year 10 which will support their GCSE courses and allow them to have the best start to year 11.
